A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.

### Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

After having blessed us with the most powerful weapon called Eucharist to be used against all kinds of evil in this world this past Sunday, today the Church reminds us that as humans, we all have an existential struggle against evil. However, the good news is that the ultimate victory is ours provided we seek the help of Jesus Christ in our daily lives.

The first reading from the book of Genesis gives us a narration of the fall of our first parents. Adam and Eve, and the consequences of disobedience. It explains the beginning of evil in the world with its destructive results. The loving relationship between man and God was destroyed, and the relationship between Adam and Eve was weakened. Not only were they disobedient, but they were also not ready to accept their fault, they tried to justify themselves by blaming each other. They both failed to take responsibility for their actions. Adam blamed: "the woman you (God) gave me." Of course, he did not blame the woman alone, he also indirectly blamed God who generously and kindly gave him a partner. On the other hand, Eve blamed: "the serpent that tempted me." Blame reigned upon blame! Do we not do the same in our lives too? Excuses do not absolve our mistakes, rather it is the attitude of humility to accept one's faults and asking for forgiveness.

In the second reading, Paul talks about the characteristics of a life lived in faith. Paul declares to the Corinthians that the many difficulties during his missionary work were God's plan for his spiritual growth and he offered all his sufferings to Jesus for the Salvation of the world, which gave him a glorious reward from the Lord and for all believers who did the same. From his own experience Paul reminds us that an effective preaching of the Gospel is possible only through true faith.

Today's Gospel passage challenges us to face rejection with prophetic courage and optimism. The Gospel narrates Jesus' encounter with His people and family who thought that He was out of His mind. They accused Him of being possessed and tried to disgrace His ministry with false charges. Despite all these, He remained focused. Very often our friends, families, or childhood companions fail to listen to our good advice, and encouragement that we offer to them because they know so much about us and are so used to us, they disregard what we have to say. But we must face such rejection with prophetic courage because by our Baptism we are called to be prophets like Jesus, sharing His prophetic mission.

Jesus came to save everyone who believes in Him. Of course, Mary, His Mother is a great example for

us. In the Gospel, Jesus did not disrespect His own faithful mother, rather. He teaches us that, through faith and obedience to God's will, we all can become members of His blessed and happy family. Also, Jesus reminds us that it is not status, but action in response to God's call that determines who belongs to His family. To become part of the Jesus' family we are called to have a personal encounter with Jesus which is possible only through our faithfulness and obedience to God's will. Let us remember that by Baptism we become the children of God, brothers and sisters of Jesus, and members of the Heavenly family of the Triune God. However, let us examine ourselves personally, do I live according to the standards of the Jesus' Family? God Bless.
