A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.

Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

We all began our special journey with Christ on Ash Wednesday. The season of Lent gives us the opportunity to relive and experience the Paschal mystery of Christ. Thus, it exposes us to the other dimensions of our spiritual life. Being the first Sunday of Lent, the Holy Mother Church invites us to reflect on the Temptation of Jesus in the wilderness, because the Church wants to remind us that temptations come to everybody, not only to Jesus.

Today's readings highlight faith, salvation, and victory over temptations and sin. These remind us of the need to praise God for the wonders He worked in the lives of our fathers in faith. Thus, the reading reminds us that through our active participation in this Lent, God is ready to perform the same wonders to our lives too. The first reading describes the ancient Jewish ritual of presenting the first fruits and gifts to God during the harvest festival in order to thank Him for liberating His people from Egypt and for strengthening them during the years of their trials and temptations in the desert. This reminds us of our own salvific journey, especially during this season of Lent.

The second reading presents another dimension to this journey towards salvation. St. Paul warns the early Christians converted from Judaism not to yield to their constant temptation to return to the observances of the Mosaic Laws. He reminds them that they will be saved only by acknowledging the risen Jesus as Lord and Savior. It presents faith as a necessary tool which must be manifested through our confessions. Without faith, it will be practically impossible to reach our destination. In this case, Faith is the energy that motivates us as we march on. If we become weary along this journey during this season, turning to Jesus is the best option available to us. If we call upon Him in faith, we shall find the strength to continue. So, we cannot prevail in this journey by our own strength alone.

In today's Gospel, Christ was tempted by Satan. So, it is important to note that the devil is always looking for an opportunity to tempt us. When the devil realized that Christ was very hungry, he felt it was an opportunity to tempt Him. However, the good news is that the devil was wrong. Christ did not fall to his tricks. The Bible scholars think that the temptations of Jesus are the inner struggle Jesus experienced throughout His public life. The devil was trying to prevent Jesus from accomplishing His mission of saving mankind from the bondage of sin. Remember that the devil cannot overcome us, unless we give him a chance in our lives. So, Peter warns us: "Be sober-minded: be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour" (1 Pt 5:8).

So, in this first week of Lent, the message that we need to learn from the readings is that we need to confront and conquer temptations as Jesus did, using the means He employed. Jesus is our model for conquering temptations through prayer, penance, and the effective use of the "Word of God" in Scripture. Temptations make us true warriors of God by strengthening our minds and hearts. Please remember that we are never tempted beyond the strength God has given to us.

Finally, the reading reminds us that trusting only in our efforts will not be enough to make our Lenten journey successful and meaningful. This alone might fail us. However, through our faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, God is ready to assist us just as He did for our fathers in faith. So, with the psalmist let us constantly pray during this season: "Be with me, O Lord in my distress." Thus, let us celebrate this Holy season through our prayers, reconciliation and sharing. **God Bless.**
