This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.

Dear friends in Jesus Christ,

Today, we live in a world where nobody wants to talk about their weak side. Nobody wants to talk and hear about the topic of sin. Everyone wants to hide their weakness and pretend that they are the best people in the community/society. Unfortunately, we Christians are a big part of this sad situation too. Yes, most of us put on masks and walk around, and that makes the world more vulnerable. Let us not forget that Jesus hates and condemns hypocrisy. Pope Francis says, "A true Christian is a joyful Christian." So, let us be a true Christian by sharing the joy of Christ.

What do you think, what should be the basic quality of a true disciple of Jesus be or be a joyful Christian? The readings of today explains to us that humility is one of the basic qualities to be a true disciple of Jesus; humility to accept the word of God and live, humility to accept everyone as he is or as she is, humility to accept what we are, etc. If it is so, how many of us can say that we are a true disciple of Jesus? As a Christian, our model in this world should not be of anything of this world and in this world, but our Lord Jesus Christ, "who humbled Himself, took the form of a man and obedient unto death on a cross." So, to have the humility in our lives, Jesus says to us: "learn from me. for I am meek and humble of heart." Thus, humility is the quality of a person who has the presence of God with him/her.

In the readings today, we can see three holy people claiming that they are sinful. In the first reading we see Isaiah the greatest prophet, who says "woe to me. I am lost! For I am a man of unclean lips, for my eves have seen the king, the Lord of hosts." In the second reading we see that the great apostle of gentiles St. Paul says, "I am the least of the apostles, unfit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the Church of God. But by the grace of God, I am what I am." When we come to the Gospel reading, we see that Peter is making his confession before the Lord saying; "depart from me, O Lord, for I am a sinful man."

These three personalities of humility had a great experience of God, which made them into an outstanding soldier for Christ in this world. Today, as we reflect about this Gospel, an important question that each of us should ask personally is-Am I a good soldier of Christ through my life in this world? Being part of the Catholic Church, we have had so many opportunities to experience God through the celebration of the Word of God, Sacraments, prayers etc., but how well do we use them all? The reason for our failure to experience God through the sacraments and the word of God, is because of our lack of humility. Yes, the reading of today, invites all of us to

have a humility of heart to accept our failures before the Lord, which is essential to experience God. But how well do we use the sacrament of confession in our life? Jesus reminds us very clearly, "therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift." (Mathew 5:23-24)

Dear friends, the prophet Isaiah, St. Paul and St. Peter they all acknowledged, what they are before the Lord. In the same way, only when you and I make a sincere effort to acknowledge what we are then, we will be able to hear the call of God clearly and follow Him like a true disciple. So, during this mass, let us ask for the grace of humility to accept our sinfulness, so that we may be able to experience God through the celebration of the Word of God and Sacraments.
